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
HISTORY OF BAUHAUS

Paul Mondrian was essentially Neoplasticism / De Stijl.

Bauhaus school was founded by Walter Gropius, a German architect and widely seen as one of the trailblazing members of modernist architecture; the Bauhaus school translates to a construction house. This can be not very clear since the actual school didn't even have an architecture department in its early years but would go on nonetheless to profoundly influence modern design, modernist architecture, art, and architectural and plan instruction. Throughout its short life, the school and its design philosophy existed in the following cities and periods: Weimar (1919 to 1925) Dessau (1925 to 1932) Berlin (1932 to 1933)

The school was forced to close under intimidation from the Nazi regime, with its directors and staff being forced to leave Germany and emigrate to various countries all over the world. This dispersion of its faculty was a significant factor in helping to spread the Bauhaus design aesthetic worldwide.

WHAT IS CMYK?

CMYK full name is Cyan-Magenta-Yellow-Black. CMYK is a color model in which all the colors are described as a mixture of these four color process. This is a standard color model used in offset printing for full-color documents. Because such distribution uses inks of these four primary colors, it is often called four-color printing.

The CMYK is entirely masking colors on lighter, usually on white background. The ink reduces the light that would otherwise be reflected. This is called subtractive because inks "subtract" the colors red, green, and blue from white light. White light minus red leaves cyan, white light minus green leaves magenta, and white light minus blue leaves yellow.

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WHAT IS RGB?

RGB is an additive color system because the combinations of red, green, and blue light create the colors that we perceive by stimulating the different types of cone cells simultaneously.

Why red, green, and blue, you might ask? The answer for this red, green, and blue are the primary colors that can combine to observe any other color from the visible spectrum that the human eye can see.

RGB is the best for screen applications. Each color channel is expressed from 0 (least saturated) to 255 (most saturated). This means the different colors should be represented by 16,777,216 in the RGB color space.

DIFFERENCE

Both CMYK and RGB are modes for mixing color in graphic design. The RGB color model is best for digital work, while CMYK is used for print products. But to fully optimize your design, you need to understand the mechanisms behind each.

When to use RGB?
It can be used on a digital screen, use the RGB color mode. This would go for anything that involves computers, smartphones, tablets, TVs, cameras, etc. Turn to RGB if your design project involves. For a designer, it can engage in web & app design, branding online, social media and visual content video, digital graphics, etc. The best formats are JPEG, PSD, PNGs, and GIFs. Its best to avoid TIFF, EPS, PDF, and BMP for RGB purposes.

When to use CMYK?
CMYK used for any project design will be physically printed. CMYK can be used for the project involves branding business cards, stationery, etc. Advertising billboards, posters, flyers, etc. Merchandise t-shirts, hats, and other branded clothing, etc. And essential materials like product designing and restaurant menus. The best formats for CMYK file formats are PDFs, AI, and EPS.

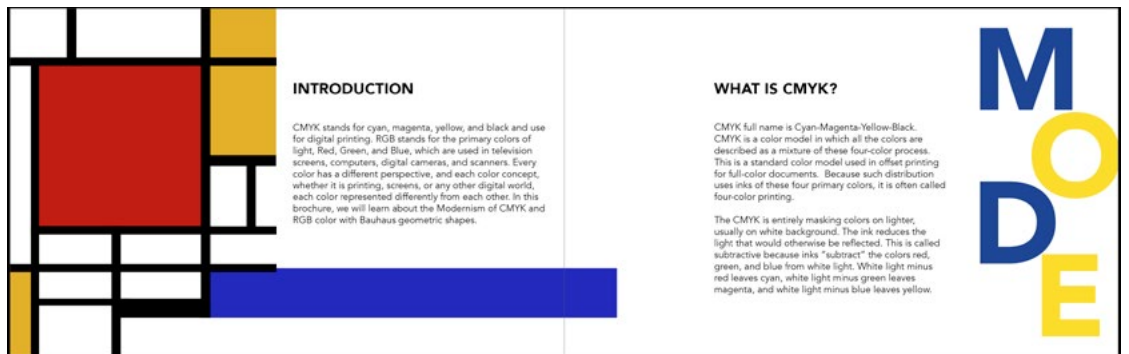
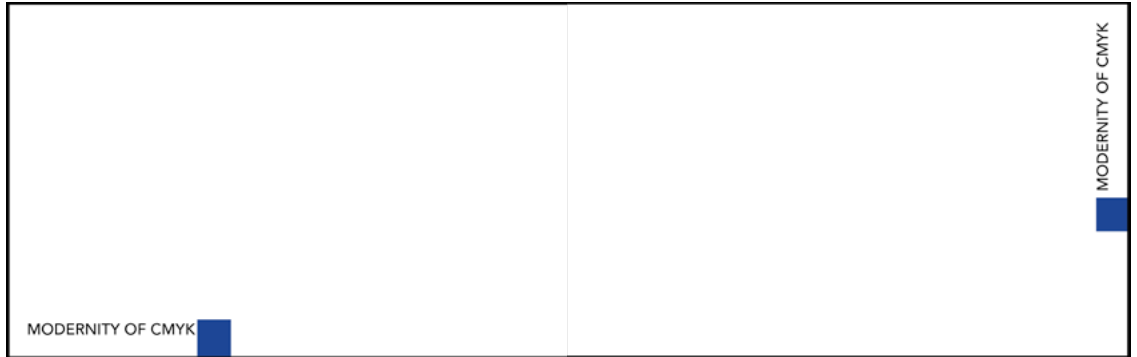
